No. 324. THE CYPRUS GOVERNMENT RAILWAY LAW, 1906.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

H. M. FOOT,
Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 2 of the Cyprus Government Railway Law, 1906, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Railway (Amendment) Regulations, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Railway Regulations, 1939 to (No. 2) 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Railway Regulations, 1939 to 1944.

2. A surcharge of 100 per centum shall be made on all rates, charges and fees set out in the First and Second Schedules to the principal Regulations in respect of goods and parcels traffic:

Provided that the minimum surcharge shall be 3p. in each case.

3. Regulation 5 of the Railway (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, is hereby

No. 325. THE ADVOCATES LAWS, 1933 TO 1940.

AUTHORIZATION UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Advocates Laws, 1933 to 1940, I hereby authorize Mr. George E. Petrides, an officer of the Medical Department, to appear, plead and act in any proceeding taken or instituted under section 19 and sections 25 to 34 (both inclusive) of the Mental Patients Law, 1931, to which the Crown, the Government of Cyprus or any officer of the Government in his official capacity is a party.

2. The authorization published under Notification No. 38 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th February, 1943, is hereby cancelled.
