## No. 324. THE CYPRUS GOVERNMENT RAILWAY LAW, 1906.

Regulations made under Section 2.

## II. M. Foot, <br> Acting (iovernor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exerciso of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 2 of the Cypras Government Railway Law, 1906, do hereby make the following regulations :-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Railway (Amendment) Regulations, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Railway Regulations, 1939 to (No. 2) 1943, (hereinafter reforred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as tho Railway Regulations, 1939 to 19.4.
2. A surcharge of 100 per centum shall bo made on all rates, charges and fees set out in the First and Second Schedules to the prineipal Regulations in respect of goods and parcels traflie:

Provided that the minimum surcharge shall be $3 p$. in each case.
3. Regulation 5 of the Railway (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, is hereby

No. 325. THE ADVOCATES LAWS, 1933 TO 1940.
Authorization under Section 12.
In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Advocates Laws, 1933 to 1940 , I hereby authorize Mr. George E. Petrides, an officer of the Medical Department, to appear, plead and act in any proceeding taken or instituted under section 19 and sections 25 to 34 (both inclusive) of the Mental Patients Law, 1931, to which the Crown, the Government of Cyprus or any officer of the Government in his official capacity is a party.
2. The authorization published under Notification No. 38 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 11th February, 1943, is hereby cancelled.
