THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE No. 153 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 10 and the substitution therefor of the following Part:—

“PART 10.—BROAD BEANS.

Purchase price from producers in villages	Wholesale Price	Retail Price in towns and villages
7½ piastres per oke.	8 piastres per oke.	9 piastres per oke.

In this part of the Schedule—
the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of broad beans in quantities in excess of 40 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.”

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 13 and the substitution therefor of the following Part:—

“PART 13.—CHICKPEAS.

(1)	(2)	(3)
Purchase price from producers in villages	Wholesale Price	Retail Price in towns and villages
9 piastres per oke.	9½ piastres per oke.	10½ piastres per oke.

In this part of the Schedule—
the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of chickpeas in quantities in excess of 40 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.”

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended, with effect from the 13th October, 1944, by the deletion therefrom of Part 24 and the substitution therefor of the following Part:—

“PART 24.—PETROL.

Price for every 4 gallons in bulk ex pump, sleeve cap tin or 2-gallon can.	Price for every 4 gallons in new sealed tin (i.e. with tin).
12 shillings and 1½ piastres.	13 shillings and 5½ piastres.”
