CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1944.
ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2140 made under Section 52.

I, the Aeting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of tho Customs Laws, 1936 to 1944 , do hereby order as follows :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (R.A.S.C./E.F.I. Goods and Stores) Exemption Order, 1944.
2. All goods nud stores imported into the Colony by R.A.S.C./E.F.I. for the use of Mis Majesty's Forces or any other persons who under R.A.S.C./E.F.I. Regulations are entitlod to the use thereof, duly certified as such by the Officer in charge of the R.A.S.C./E.F.I. in Cyprus or his deputy, shall bo admitted free of any import duty.
3. This Order shall be deemed to have been made on the lst day of January, 1944.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

Notice No. 156 under Clause 13.
A.-The Srhedule is herely amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 6 and the substitution therefor of the following Part:-
"PART 6.-COHFED.


In this Part of the Schedule-
the term 'mixed ground coffee' means a mixture of roasted ground coffee and roasted ground barley or wheat bourgouri in proportion of $70 \%$ and $30 \%$ respectively;
the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of mixed ground coffee in quantities in excess of 5 okes at any one time or at any single transaction."
B.-The Schedulo is hereby amended, with effect from the 9 th November, 1944, by the deletion therefrom of Parts 22 and 24 and the substitution therefor of the following Parts respectively :-
"Part 22.-GAS OIL.
