No. 397. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1944.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2149

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

H. M. Foot,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1944, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Unfaced Mother-of-Pearl Blanks) Exemption Order, 1944.

2. From and after the 1st January, 1945, all unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks imported into the Colony by any person who satisfies the Comptroller of Customs that—

- (a) he is a *bona fide* button manufacturer; and
- (b) he imports such unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks solely for the purpose of manufacturing buttons therefrom for export from the Colony; and
- (c) such unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks are of British Empire origin,

shall be admitted free from all import duties:

Provided that before clearance from the Customs the importer shall sign a declaration in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

THE IMPORT DUTY (UNFACED MOTHER-OF-PEARL BLANKS)
EXEMPTION ORDER, 1944.

I, the undersigned.....
of..... being the importer of the following unfaced
mother-of-pearl blanks, that is to say—

hereby declare as follows:—

- (a) I have imported the said blanks solely for the purpose of manufacturing buttons therefrom for export and for no other purpose ;
(b) I agree that the Comptroller or any person authorized by him in that behalf shall, at all times, have the power and right to enter any premises or place wherein or whereon the said blanks will be stored or manufactured for the purpose of inspecting such premises or place and for ensuring that the terms of this declaration are being complied with and I further agree and undertake to supply the Comptroller with any information which he may require touching such blanks and the manner of their disposal.
2. If I fail to observe the provisions of this declaration I hereby agree and undertake to pay to the Comptroller, upon his request, the full import duty for the time being in force for any unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks imported as aforesaid.
