THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council 1942, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Amendment) Regulations, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944.

2. The following regulation shall be inserted in the principal Regulations

certain cases.

immediately after regulation 22A thereof:—
"Restriction 22AA.—(1) The Governor, if satisfied, with respect to any alien, of movements that for the maintenance of public order or the maintenance of of aliens in supplies or of services essential to the life of the community, it is necessary to do so, may make an order for securing that, except in so far as he may be permitted by the order or by such authority as may be specified in the order, that alien shall not be in any such area in the Colony, as may be specified, and for requiring him to notify his movements in such manner at such times and to such authority or person as may be specified in the order.

(2) If any alien is in any area in contravention of an order made under this regulation or fails to leave any area in accordance with the requirements of such an order, then, without prejudice to any proceedings which may be taken against him, he may be removed from that area by any officer of police or by any person authorized in that behalf by the Governor.

(3) For the purposes of these regulations-

alien' means a person who is not a British subject and who has entered the Colony since the 3rd day of September, 1939.

No. 47. THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13 (2).
