THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council 1942, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Suspension of the Fruit Trees Protection Law, 1891, and of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1942,) (In certain Cases), Regulations, 1944.

2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations—

| (b) the operation of regulation 16 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1942, shall, in so far as it relates to the transport or conveyance of any timber or other forest produce from any land, which does not form part of a Main State Forest or a Minor State Forest or a private forest placed under the control of the Government, and which is within any area declared as Fuelwood Controlled Area under the provisions of the Defence (Control of Fuel and Charcoal) Orders, 1943, be suspended; | 30.12.1940

| (c) the operation of regulations 19, 22 and 23 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1942, shall, in so far as they relate to the erection, use or working of any kiln for making or producing charcoal within any area declared as Charcoal Controlled Area under the provisions of the Defence (Control of Fuel and Charcoal) Orders, 1943, be suspended. | 30.12.1940
