THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

6-4-44, p. 83.

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as a Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Cheese Makers Control) Order, 1944.

2. For the purposes of this Order—

“cheese” means the types of cheese known as *kaskavalli*, *kefalotyri*, *teleme*, *fetta* and similar types, but does not include the types known as *halloumi* or *anari*.

3.—(1) From and after the 1st March, 1944, no person shall make or manufacture cheese save under a special permit issued under my hand, upon a written application therefor in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto.

(2) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (1) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the quantity and description of cheese to be produced monthly and the price at which such cheese may be sold or purchased) as may be specified therein.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order or any term or condition contained in any special permit issued under the provisions of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944.
