REV. No. 69. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the 20.1245 Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, I hereby order as follows:— 725′ 1. 1116 Order, 1944. 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Insecticides)

2. In this Order-

"Insecticide" means pyrethrum powder, pyrethrum extracts whether diluted or concentrated and includes all made up fly spray or insecticide whether branded or not.

3. Within four days from the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette. every person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of insecticide in powder form in excess of 1 kilogram or any quantity of insecticide in liquid form in excess of 2 gallons or 10 litres shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto in respect of the insecticide in his possession or under his control.

4.—(1) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette, no person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of insecticide in excess of the quantities mentioned in clause 3 of this Order shall-

(a) consume or make use of; (b) sell or otherwise dispose of;

(c) in any way alter, treat, carry out any process in connection with or use in the preparation or manufacture of any liquid or preparation;

any quantity of such insecticide whatsoever, save under a special permit issued under my hand or the hand of a Deputy Controller of Medical Supplies.
