SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 89. THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Public Health) Amendment Regulations, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 to 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 to 1944.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after regulation 40 of the following regulations:—

"40A. No person who knows that he is a carrier of any dangerous infectious disease mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto shall carry on or be engaged in any trade or calling set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

40B. No employer shall knowingly employ any person being a carrier of any dangerous infectious disease mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto in any trade or calling set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

40C. If the Director of Medical Services or any Government Medical Officer suspects that any person engaged in any trade or calling set out in the Second Schedule hereto is a carrier of any dangerous infectious disease mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto he may by himself or by his authorized officer enter upon such premises where any such trade or calling is being carried on and examine the persons employed therein."

3. Regulation 42 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words "For the purposes of these regulations—" (line 1) of the following definition:—

"'carrier' means any person who harbours pathogenic organisms of any dangerous infectious disease mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto."

4. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the end of the Second Schedule of the following Schedule:—

"THIRD SCHEDULE.

Scarlet fever, cholera, diphtheria, epidemic cerebro-spinal meningitis, typhoid fever, dysentery and pulmonary tuberculosis".
