No. 100. THE FIREARMS LAWS, 1933 TO 1942.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2162

MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1) (b).

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 (1) (b) of the Firearms Laws, 1933 to 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Air-guns, Air-rifles or Air-pistols (Declaration) Order, 1945.

2. All air-guns, air-rifles or air-pistols of a calibre exceeding .177 are hereby declared to be dangerous within the meaning of section 3 (1) (b) of the aforesaid Laws.

No. 101. THE CHANGE OF TITLES LAW, 1934.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2163

MADE UNDER SECTION 4.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Change of Titles Law, 1934, do hereby order that the titles in the First and Second Columns of the Schedule hereto be added to the First and Second Columns respectively of the First Schedule to the Change of Titles Law, 1934.

2. Except for the change of the second title in the Schedule hereto which shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the 1st January, 1944, the changes in all other cases shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the 1st January, 1945.
