No. 120. THE BANK HOLIDAYS LAW, 1928.

PROCLAMATION MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Bank Holidays Law, 1928, and with the advice of the Executive Council, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that Wednesday the 9th day of May, 1945, is hereby appointed to be and shall be observed as a bank holiday for the purposes of the said Law.

Given at Nicosia, this 8th day of May, 1945.

No. 121. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

Following upon the cessation of hostilities in Europe, I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1942, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Revocation) Regulations, 1945.

2. The Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1945, are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the regulations set out in the Schedule hereto, without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
