THE CYPRUS PENSIONS ORDERS AND LAWS, 1929 TO 1944.

PENSIONABLE OFFICES DECLARED TO BE NO LONGER PENSIONABLE.

I, the Governor in Council, with the sanction of the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Cyprus Pensions Orders and Laws, 1929 to 1944, do hereby declare the pensionable offices set forth in the second column of the Schedule hereto to be no longer pensionable as from the 1st day of July, 1945:

Provided that nothing in this notification shall affect the rights acquired by any person who on the date above mentioned held any of the offices set out in the second column of the said Schedule and who does not elect to become a depositor under the provisions of the Provident Fund Law, 1945.
