I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, as amended by the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Export Duty) Schedule Amendment Order, 1945.

2. The Schedule to the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, as amended by the Customs (Export Duty) Schedule Amendment Order, 1944, is hereby further amended by the insertion therein immediately after item 6 of the following item:—

“ 6A. Donkeys . . . . . 5 per centum *ad valorem*.”

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1942, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Revocation No. 2) Regulations, 1945.
