**No. 27. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944.**

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Pedhoulas, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF PEDHOULAS.

*Rules.*

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Pedhoulas (Amendment) Rules, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Pedhoulas Rules, 1933 and 1936 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Pedhoulas Rules, 1933 to 1945.

2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "ten" and the substitution therefor of the word "thirty".
