No. 292. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following Rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Apsiou in the District of Limassol, are published in the *Gazette*.
(M.P. 949/45.)

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF APSIOU.

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Apsiou Rules, 1945.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Limassol;

"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;

"Irrigation Division" means the Irrigation Division of Apsiou;

"Law" means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944;

"list" means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law;

"works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.

3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 26th November, 1944. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the first week of the month of November and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the day next following its election.

4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.

(2) The treasurer shall, on the 31st July in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.

(3) The treasurer shall be unpaid: Provided that he shall be paid such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.

(4) The treasurer shall be appointed for such period as the Committee may fix but in no case extending over the term of office of the Committee appointing such treasurer.
