THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY TAX LAWS, 1932 TO 1942,

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2172

MADE UNDER SECTION 5A.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 5A of the Immovable Property Tax Laws, 1932 to 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Immovable Property Tax (Increase) Order, 1945.
- 2. The rate of the immovable property tax in respect of immovable property owned by any person within the limits of any town or quarter of a town shall, for the year 1946, be increased by four per thousand on the capital value of such property as assessed in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Laws.
- 3. The rate of the immovable property tax in respect of immovable property owned by any person within the limits of any village or quarter of a village shall, for the year 1946, be increased by two and a half per thousand on the capital value of such property as assessed in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Laws.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any immovable property in respect of which immovable property tax is not levied under any law in force for the time being.
