

No. 35. THE DEFENCE CONTROL OF OILBURNERS ORDER, 1944.**NOTICE No. 11 UNDER CLAUSE 2.**

I hereby specify the following to be a Controlled Oilburner for the purposes of the above Order :

Description.

The "Olymbos" is a blue flame burner with a permanent asbestos rope wick.

It consists of three tubular sections which are pierced at regularly spaced intervals, two with holes of $1/16$ " diameter and one with holes of $3/16$ " diameter, a sheet metal cover plate drilled at the centre with a $1/4$ " diameter hole, a trough to hold the asbestos rope wick, a plate drilled at centre with $7/8$ " hole, a plate drilled with $1/4$ " diameter holes at 1" centres round the outer edge, a feed pipe.

The burner is built up as follows. The main feed pipe is welded to the trough which contains the asbestos wick by two small upright pipes which actually feed the fuel to the wick. The drilled cylinders are set up one within the other, the cylinder drilled with $3/16$ " holes being the outer and is joined to the intermediate cylinder by welding at the top by four small pieces of metal, the centre cylinder is built up with the plate drilled $7/8$ " fixed at the central of the cylinder and the plate drilled with $1/4$ " holes round its periphery is fixed at the bottom. The inner cylinder is a tight hand fit to the inner periphery of the wick trough and the outer cylinder to the outside of the trough so that all the air consumed in burning has to pass through the holes in the bottom plate of the central cylinder thereby spreading through the smaller holes in this cylinder and mixing with the inflammable gases of the oil ignite with a blue flame which gives off an intense heat.

The "Olymbos" oilburner is more particularly described in drawings deposited with the Conservator of Forests.

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Yermasoyia (Amendment) Rules, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Yermasoyia Rules, 1932 and 1936, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Yermasoyia Rules, 1932 to 1945.
