

No. 387. THE MOTOR CAR LAWS, 1921 TO 1945.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Motor Car Laws, 1921 to 1945, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Car (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Motor Car Regulations, 1930 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Motor Car Regulations, 1930 to (No. 2) 1945.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part I of Schedule A thereto and the substitution therefor of the following Part :—

Provided that—

- (a) in the case of a half-yearly licence the fee shall be one half of the fee payable for an annual licence together with an additional charge of 5% of the fee payable for such annual licence ;
- (b) in the case of a licence issued in the course of any half-year or year the fee shall be one-sixth or one-twelfth of the total fee payable for a half-yearly or yearly licence, as the case may be, for every month or part of a month still to elapse before the end of the half year or the year, as the case may be ;
- (c) any person in possession of a valid licence who intends to leave the Colony without requiring the Registrar to register the car temporarily in the name of another person under regulation 7 (b) of these regulations, shall be allowed a refund in full in respect of each complete quarter still to run.

Exemptions.

- (a) Motor cars for demonstration purposes registered under the provisions of Regulation 10.
- (b) Any motor car belonging to the Governor or to the Government.
- (c) Motor tractors.
- (d) Motor cars used by any Municipal Corporation for watering or other sanitary purposes within the Municipal limits over which such Municipal Corporation exercises authority."
