No. 50. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2157

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, (to No. 2) 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1944 to 1945.
