THE SHIPPING DUES LAWS, 1917 TO 1944.

FAMAGUSTA HARBOUR REGULATIONS.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 to 1944, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Famagusta Harbour (Anchorage, Gazette: Berthage and Mooring Boat) (Amendment) Regulations, 1945, and shall be read Supplement as one with the Famagusta Harbour (Anchorage, Berthage and Mooring Boat) No. 3: Regulations, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and 31.8.1944 the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Famagusta Harbour (Anchorage, Berthage and Mooring Boat) Regulations, 1944 and 1945.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion in line one of sub paragraph (2) of regulation 3 immediately after the words " prescribed in " of the words "sub-paragraph (a) of ".

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1945.

THE SHIPPING DUES LAWS, 1917 TO 1944.

LARNACA, LIMASSOL AND PAPHOS PORTS REGULATIONS.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 to 1944, do hereby make the following regulations :-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Larnaca, Limassol and Paphos Ports (Berthage) (Amendment) Regulations, 1945 and shall be read as one with the Larnaca, Limassol and Paphos Ports (Berthage) Regulations, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Larnaca, Limassol and Paphos Ports (Berthage) Regulations, 1944 and 1945.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion in line two of sub-paragraph (2) of regulation 3 immediately after the words " unloading cargo " of the word " not ".

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1945.
