

**No. 8. THE ADULTERATION OF PRODUCE LAWS, 1926 TO 1935.**

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

H. M. FOOT,

*Acting Governor.*

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 10 of the Adulteration of Produce Laws, 1926 to 1935, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Adulteration of Produce (Local Sales) Regulations, 1945.

2. The proportion of foreign ingredients or extraneous matter permitted in the sale or preparation for sale in the Colony of any of the produce set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall not be greater than the maximum percentage set out in the second column of such Schedule against each such produce and any produce containing any foreign ingredients or extraneous matter in excess of such percentages shall be deemed to be adulterated:

Provided that in the case of wheat, out of the total maximum percentage of foreign ingredients or extraneous matters set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto, the percentage of darnel (commonly known as Koumdoura) shall in no case exceed one per centum.

3. In the case of carobs, what are commonly known as "wild carobs" shall be deemed to be a foreign ingredient or extraneous matter.

4. The Adulteration of Produce (Local Sales) Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1942 are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

**No. 9. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1944.**

DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER REGULATION 66 (5).
