**No. 116. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1945.****ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2189**

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1945, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) (Amendment) Order, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Orders, 1943 and 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Orders, 1943 to 1946.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 2 and the substitution therefor of the following clause :—

"2. Subject to clause 3 of this Order all Customs Houses shall be open for the transaction of business on every day in the week as follows :—

(a) In the months of June to October, both months inclusive, in every year—

(i) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays;

(ii) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesdays;

(iii) from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays;

(b) in the months of November in every year to May of the following year, both months inclusive—

(i) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays;

(ii) from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays."
