Whereas by a Proclamation made on the 10th day of February, 1946, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th February, 1946, Georghios Themistokli of Panayia has been declared to be an outlaw and was required to surrender himself into the custody of the Police at any place in the Colony not later than the 23rd day of February, 1946;
