THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE  
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Movement of Bread) Order, 1946.

2. From and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* and save under a written permit issued by the Commissioner of the District, no person, shall remove, take or transport any bread from the town or village at which it was baked to any place situated more than one mile outside the boundary of such town or village:

Provided that nothing in this clause shall apply to any loaf of bread not exceeding one oke in weight, if such loaf is cut at least into two pieces.

3. Any bread removed, taken or transported in contravention of the provisions of clause 2 of this Order may be seized by such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf.
