THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 207 (1).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 207 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1945, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Municipal Elections (Closing of Licensed Premises) (Nicosia) Order, 1946.

2. In this Order—

“licensed premises” means any premises licensed for the sale of intoxicating liquors by retail under the provisions of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors Law, 1943.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order, 1945,—

(a) all licensed premises situated within the municipal limits of the villages of Kythrea and Morphou shall be closed and remain closed from 1 a.m. on the 12th day of May, 1946, until 6 a.m. on the 13th day of May, 1946;

(b) all licensed premises situated within the municipal limits of the town of Nicosia shall be closed and remain closed from 1 a.m. on the 26th day of May, 1946, until 6 a.m. on the 27th day of May, 1946.
