**No. 163.****THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 AND 1944.**

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Dhrinia in the District of Paphos, are published in the *Gazette*.

**IRRIGATION DIVISION OF DHRINIA.***Rules.*

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Dhrinia (Amendment) Rules, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Dhrinia Rules, 1944 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”) and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Dhrinia Rules, 1944 and 1946.

2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “twenty shillings” and the substitution therefor of the words “forty shillings”.
