**NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 6.**

It is hereby notified for general information that in virtue of the authority vested in him by regulation 6 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1944, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that the Minor State Forests, the areas of which are set out in the Schedule to the Minor State Forests (Famagusta) Orders, 1943 to 1946, shall be reserved as Village Fuel Areas.

2. The notice published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 9th March, 1944, under Notification No. 82, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

**No. 227. THE HOTELS LAWS, 1935 TO 1943.**

**REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 12.**

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Hotels Laws, 1935 to 1943, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Regulations, 1935 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Hotels Regulations, 1935 to 1946.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—
