THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933. No. 248.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2200

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

- I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:-
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Gazette: Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 (hereinafter referred to as "the No. 3: principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may 2. 5.1946 together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946.

- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows :-
 - (a) by the addition thereto in their alphabetical order of the new entries set out in the First Schedule hereto;
 - (b) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to Algeria, Corsica and France, and the substitution therefor of the entries set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

No. 249. THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1944.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

C. C. WOOLLEY,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Elementary Education

(Books in Moslem Schools) Regulations, 1946.

2. From and after the 1st day of September, 1946, the books set out in the Schedule hereto shall be the books to be used as reading books in all Moslem schools.
