THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO 1944, AS AMENDED BY THE AMENDMENT OF THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941, (DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1942.

PROCLAMATION MADE UNDER SECTION 11A.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

Whereas by section 11A of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to 1944, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, it is enacted that the Governor may, by Proclamation, call out and mobilize the Force or any part thereof for actual service whenever it appears advisable to do so:

And whereas it appears to me advisable to call out and mobilize a certain officer:

Now, therefore, I, Roland Evelyn Turnbull, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11A of the said Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to 1944, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, do hereby, by this Proclamation, call out and mobilize Captain C. W. Dallas as from the 1st day of January, 1946.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Nicosia this 30th day of January, 1946.

No. 27. THE FOREST LAW, 1939 (Section 10)

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1945,

(NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4).

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is expedient that certain immovable properties, comprising mainly drifting sand dunes, in the Main State Forest of Ayia Erini, in the District of Kyrenia, should be acquired by the Government.

Now, therefore, I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 10 of the Forest Law, 1939, and sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1945, do hereby declare the acquisition of the said immovable properties to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Conservator of Forests the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.

## THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, No. 28. 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13 (2).

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 13 (2) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, do hereby order that the Order relating to the Tree Planting Area of the village of Nata published in the Gazette of the 14th February, 1936, under

Notification No. 152, shall be extended for a further period of five years from the date of the expiration thereof.

No. 29. THE COMPANIES (LIMITED LIABILITY) LAWS, 1922 TO 1944.

LICENCE UNDER SECTION 20.

Whereas it has been proved to the satisfaction of His Excellency the Acting Governor that the Pancyprian Pharmaceutical Association which is about to be formed as a limited company under the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, is to be formed for the purpose of promoting objects of the nature contemplated by section 20 of the said Laws, and that it is the intention of the said Association that the profits, if any, or the income or property of the Association, whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association, as set forth in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association, and that no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to its members or to any of them or to any person claiming through any of them:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 20 of the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, and in consideration of the provisions and subject to the conditions contained in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association, as subscribed by sixty-six members thereof and approved by the Court on the 22nd October, 1945, His Excellency the Acting Governor does by this licence direct the Pancyprian Pharmaceutical Association to be registered with limited liability, without the addition of the word "Limited" to its name.
