### No. 292. THE GOVERNMENT LANDS LAW, 1941.

GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby grant unto Charalambos Christodoulou Mavroyacoumou of Panayia his heirs and successors the land described in the Schedule hereto on condition that the grantee shall not be registered therefor or mortgage, sell or in any other way dispose of the same except with the consent of the Governor previously obtained and that the grantee shall not at any time buy or possess any goats either himself or jointly with others.

### No. 293. THE CYPRUS CURRENCY NOTES ORDER AND LAW, 1928 AND 1935.

RULES MADE UNDER ARTICLE XV.

C. C. WOOLLEY,

*Governor.*

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article XV of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935, with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes (Amendment) Rules, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to 1946.

2. The second proviso to rule 17 of the principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following proviso substituted therefor:—

"Provided further that nothing in this rule shall apply to currency notes of denominations of 3 piastres, 1s. and 2s."
