AND  
**THE DEFENCE LEGISLATION (INCORPORATION IN CERTAIN LAWS) LAW, 1946.**

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, as amended by the Defence Legislation (Incorporation in Certain Laws) Law, 1946, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Export Duty) Schedule Amendment Order, 1946.

2. The Schedule to the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of item 3 and the substitution therefor of the following item:—

“3. Carobs, including the meal, seed and gum  
of carobs .. .. . 4 per centum  
*ad valorem.*”

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**No. 318. THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAW, 1938.**
