(2) A permit issued under sub-clause (1) hereof may contain such terms, limitations and conditions as may be specified therein;

(3) Subject to any term or condition contained in a permit granted under this clause, the provisions of this Order shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to any person to whom a permit has been granted under this clause as they apply to other persons who are registered importers under the provisions of this Order."

4. Clause 28 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
(a) by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (g) of sub-clause 2 and the substitution therein of the following paragraph—

'(g) insecticides other than Dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane insecticides (commonly known as D.D.T. insecticides)";

(b) by the insertion therein of the following sub-clause (3)—
"(3) For the purposes of this clause the word "Insecticides" means any liquid or powder used as a fly spray, whether branded or not, and includes diluted ready made preparations of Dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane (commonly known as D.D.T.) solely for agricultural, or horticultural, or veterinary purposes or moth killers".
