## No. 330. THE GOVERNMENT LANDS LAW, 1941.

GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

## C. C. WOOLLEY,

Governor.

I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby grant unto the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and townsmen of the town of Kyrenia, (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation"), the land described in the Schedule hereto, (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the conditions as follows, that is to say:—

(a) that the land shall not be registered in the name of the Corporation nor shall the Corporation charge, sell or otherwise dispose of the same but that it shall lay out, use, keep and maintain the said land at all times as a public garden for the benefit and enjoyment of all sections of the community of, and of all other members of the public resorting to, the town of Kyrenia;

(b) that, on breach of any of the conditions hereinbefore set out, the grant shall be revoked and that in such case—

(i) the Corporation shall, forthwith, vacate the land; and (ii) any erections, plantations and any other improvements whatsoever effected in or upon the land shall vest in, and become the property of, the Crown without payment to the Corporation of any compensation whatsoever.
