THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO 1944.

PROCLAMATION MADE UNDER SECTION 11A.

C. C. WOOLLEY,

Governor.

I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11A of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to 1944, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby, by this Preclamation, demobilize Captain Ch. X. Liassides with effect from the 1st August, 1946.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Troodos, this 2nd day of October, 1946.
