IRRIGATION DIVISION OF MAZOTOS.

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Mazotos Rules, 1946.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca;

“Committee” means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;

“Irrigation Division” means the Irrigation Division of Mazotos;
