

**No. 362.****THE PUBLIC HEALTH (ANTI-MALARIA) LAWS, 1944 AND 1945.****REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 7.**

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Laws, 1944 and 1945, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) (Spraying of Vehicles, etc.) Regulations, 1946.

2. The Director of Medical Services (which expression shall include any officer of the Medical Department authorized by him in that behalf) may, with a view to preventing the transmission of malaria or the introduction of any dangerous species of anopheles mosquitoes capable of transmitting malaria, take all such steps and make all such arrangements as may be necessary for the spraying with insecticide of any vehicle, vessel or aircraft and may, for this purpose, require any passengers of the vehicle or craft to leave such vehicle or craft whilst such spraying is being carried out and every such passenger shall, forthwith, comply with such requirement.

3. Any person who fails to comply with these regulations, or who obstructs or in any way hinders the Director of Medical Services in carrying out these regulations, is liable to the penalties prescribed in section 6 of the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Laws, 1944 and 1945.

**No. 363.****THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY (TENURE, REGISTRATION AND VALUATION) LAW, 1945.****ORDER BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAND REGISTRATION AND SURVEYS UNDER SECTION 42.**
