THE GOVERNMENT LANDS LAW, 1941.

GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby grant unto each one of the persons whose name appears in the first column of the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to severally as the "grantee" which expression shall include his heirs and permitted assigns, in each case), the land described opposite his name in the second column of the Schedule, subject to the following conditions to be observed by each grantee, that is to say:

(a) each grantee shall pay to the Government of Cyprus the amount appearing

opposite his name in the third column of the Schedule;

(b) the land shall not be registered in the name of the grantee and the grantee shall not charge, sell or in any other way directly dispose of the land or any part thereof;

(c) the grantee shall not erect or cause to be erected any structure whatsoever

on the land.

And this grant is subject to this further condition, that is to say:—

Upon the breach or non-observance of any of the conditions hereinbefore stated, this grant shall be revoked and cancelled in so far as it relates to the individual grantee who is guilty of such breach or non-observance and in such case—

(a) the grantee concerned shall forthwith vacate the land; and

(b) any structure erected on the land in contravention of condition (c), as hereinbefore, shall vest in, and become the property of, the Crown without payment to the grantee of any compensation whatsoever.
