**No. 404.** BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.  
A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the village of Kato Polemidhia and the Quarter of Limassol hitherto known as Ayios Antonios :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Roland Evelyn Turnbull, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of January, 1947, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Kato Polemidhia, shall form part of the lands of Ayios Antonios Quarter of Limassol and that the boundaries of the said village of Kato Polemidhia, and Ayios Antonios Quarter of Limassol shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

The boundary of the area commences at the south-eastern corner of plot No. 162 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIV/57 on the main road from Limassol to Paphos, the point at which the road leading to the village of Kato Polemidhia leaves the said road and proceeds northwards along the said road to the village of Kato Polemidhia to the north-western corner of plot No. 160 of the said plan locality " Koutsoullia " ; thence north-eastwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 160, 157, 156, 155, 154, 137, 124 and 126 of the said plan to the most northern point of the said plot No. 126 on the right bank of the new Garyllis river ; thence south-eastwards along the right bank of the said river to the point where it meets the main road from Limassol to Paphos ; thence westwards along the said main road to the point of commencement, all which said area is shown coloured blue and hatched red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1330.
