

before sunset and half an hour after sunrise, and during that period no such petroleum shall be left in any place not approved for the purpose by the Collector or his representative.

109. When petroleum is imported in bulk, its removal from the ship shall be effected in such manner and at such time as may be directed by the Director of Public Works."

3. These regulations shall come into operation on the 24th day of February, 1946.

No. 54. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1945.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Whereas by reason of the resignation of certain councillors of the Municipal Corporation of Akanthou (hereinafter referred to as "the said Corporation"), the number of councillors of the said Corporation capable of acting has fallen below one third of the total number of councillors as directed in accordance with the provisions of section 10 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1945, in respect of the said Corporation ;

And whereas in consequence thereof the council of the said Corporation is deemed to have expired ;

Now, therefore, I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 62 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1945, do hereby appoint the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto to be a Municipal Commission for the said Corporation to have the powers and perform all the duties of the council of the said Corporation which has expired as hereinbefore stated, until another council shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of the said section.
