THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13 (2).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 13 (2) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, do hereby order that the Orders relating to the Tree Planting Areas of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, published in the Gazettes set out in the second column of the said Schedule, shall be extended for a further period of five years from the date of the expiration thereof.

No. 88. THE MATCHES (EXCISE DUTY) LAW, 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 12.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Matches (Excise Duty) Law, 1935, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Matches (Excise Duty) (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, and shall be read as one with the

Matches (Excise Duty) Regulations, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Matches (Excise Duty) Regulations, 1946 and (No. 1) 1946.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (1) and the substitution therefor

of the following paragraph:-

"(1) For the purposes of these regulations, a container shall mean a packet containing 12 boxes of matches or any multiple of 12 boxes of matches or 36 booklets of matches or any multiple of 36 booklets of matches of the same shape and capacity, the whole enclosed in paper, cardboard or other wrapping."
