

Matches (Excise Duty) Regulations, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Matches (Excise Duty) Regulations, 1946 and (No. 1) 1946.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (1) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

"(1) For the purposes of these regulations, a container shall mean a packet containing 12 boxes of matches or any multiple of 12 boxes of matches or 36 booklets of matches or any multiple of 36 booklets of matches of the same shape and capacity, the whole enclosed in paper, cardboard or other wrapping."
