For the purposes of this Order the expression "Germany" means Berlin and the French, British, American and Russian Military Zones of Germany as established by the statement by the Governments of the United Kingdom, the United States of America, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Provisional Government of the French Republic on the zones of occupation in Germany on the 5th June, 1945, and also those parts of the former German Reich which are at present administered by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 4th March, 1947.
