THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAWS, 1938 AND 1946.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2273

MADE UNDER SECTION 25 (a) (i).

Authority to the Summer Resort Development Board of Prodhromos to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 25 (a) (i) of the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Summer Resort Development Board of Prodhromos (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Government of Cyprus (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") a sum not exceeding six thousand five hundred pounds (£6,500) at a rate of interest not exceeding three and one quarter per centum (3¼%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say—

- (a) that the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Government in thirty equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the purpose of—
 - (i) improving the drinking water supply of the village of Prodhromos (£2,000); and
 - (ii) constructing a new market, a slaughter house and offices for the Board (£4,500).

2. That for the purpose of securing the repayment of the said sum of six thousand five hundred pounds the Board shall, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, mortgage to the Government all the properties of the Board and all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Board.
