ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2289 MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

THE PIERS LAW, 1947.

LICENCE UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,

Governor.

Whereas a licence dated 28th July, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the Licence"), was given by the then Acting Governor in Council under section 6 of the Piers Law, 1947, to the Tunnel Asbestos Cement Company Limited, of Horseferry House, Westminster, London, S.W.1, (hereinafter referred to as "the Old Company"), to use and maintain the pier therein described in accordance with the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the Memorandum of Agreement"), set out in the Schedule to the Licence;

And whereas the Old Company has, by an agreement dated the 15th day of August, 1947, between the Old Company, of the one part, and the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, of 22A T. P. O'Connor Street, Limassol (hereinafter referred to as "the New Company"), of the other part, sold to the New Company its Cypriot assets including the benefit of the Memorandum of Agreement;

And whereas the Old Company and the New Company have now requested that the rights, interests and obligations of the Old Company under the Memorandum of Agreement and the Licence should be

transferred to and vested in the New Company;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 27 of the Interpretation Law, 1935, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby direct that the Licence be amended by substituting therein for the Old Company the New Company as licensee thereunder, for all the purposes of the Licence.
