- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Famagusta Municipal (Amendment No. 2) Bye-laws, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1948.
- 2. Bye-law 33 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor:—
  - "33. No person shall sell or expose for sale any perishable goods outside the markets for perishable goods except under a permit from the Council or the Mayor granted pursuant to bye-law 34 or 35:

Provided that potatoes and citrus destined only for export may be sold outside the Municipal Markets and no fees shall be payable in respect thereof as provided by bye-law 12."

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 615/12/5.)
