(b) the Fund to be established in respect of the said Village Fuel Area in accordance with the provisions of regulation 12 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1944,

No. 174. THE PORT REGULATION LAWS, 1879 TO 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 3 of the Port Regulation Laws, 1879 to 1935, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations.

- 2. These regulations may be cited as the Pilotage (Amendment) Regulations, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Pilotage Regulations, 1935 to 1943 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Pilotage Regulations, 1935 to 1948.
- 3. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations (as set out in the Pilotage (Amendment) Regulations, 1943) is hereby deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

"5.—(1) The fees to be paid by vessels in respect of pilotage into, manoeuvring within, or pilotage out of, the Port of Famagusta shall be as follows:—

Provided that these fees shall include the use of a tug in connection with the manoeuvring upon entry into, change of berth within, and departure from the Port of Famagusta, as the pilot may deem necessary, but no vessel shall/be exempt from the payment of such fees or any part thereof by reason that the use of a tug was not deemed necessary by the pilot or that a tug is not available.

(2) The fees to be paid by vessels in respect of pilotage into, manoeuvring within, or pilotage out of, any port, except the Port

of Famagusta, shall be as follows:-

(a) For vessels not exceeding 1,500 tons register ... 2 0 0 (b) For vessels exceeding 1,500 tons register ... 3 0 0

(3) The Comptroller may, with the approval of the Governor, exempt any vessel from the payment of any of the fees set out in paragraph (1) or (2) of this regulation."
