

**No. 215. THE FOREST LAW, 1939 (SECTION 10)
AND
THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

WINSTER,
Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is expedient that certain immovable property in the Main Forest of Troodos, in the District of Nicosia, in the vicinity of Kalopanayiotis village at the locality "Pokamatismos", should be acquired by the Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 10 of the Forest Law, 1939, and sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the acquisition of the said immovable property to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Conservator of Forests the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.

No. 216. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1948.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1948, and duly deputed to me, I hereby approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the firms whose names are set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the firm whose name is set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be private warehouses for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry of such goods therein.
