A PROCLAMATION.

WINSTER,
Governor.

Whereas in pursuance of Article 3 of the Cyprus Coinage Order and Law, 1900 and 1948, new mixed metal coins of two Cyprus shillings and one Cyprus shilling have, at my request and with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury and the Secretary of State, been coined under the direction of the Master of His Majesty's Mint for use in the Colony of Cyprus :

And whereas by paragraph (5) of the said Article it is, *inter alia*, provided that if any new coins are coined in pursuance of that Article and a Proclamation is made with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury setting forth in a Schedule the like particulars with respect to each coin as are set forth in the Third Schedule to the said Order and Law, the provisions of the said Order and Law making the coins in the said Third Schedule current and legal tender in the Colony of Cyprus shall apply to the new coins as if the Schedule to the Proclamation formed part of the Third Schedule to the Order and Law :

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, do hereby proclaim that the Schedule hereto sets forth the particulars with respect to the said new mixed metal coins of two Cyprus shillings and one Cyprus shilling which are required by paragraph (5) of the said Article.
