No. 242. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5.

With reference to the Notification published under No. 391 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 3343 of the 18th December, 1947, and to the notice under No. 56 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 3355 of the 12th February, 1948, supplemental notice is given that lands required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned in the Notification as aforesaid are also situated in the villages of Masari, Kyra, Ayia Marina (Skylouras) and Skylloura in the District of Nicosia.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands is required within six weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands to which this notice relates is available for inspection at my office in Nicosia.
